North Carolinians Dance to Support Hospices Across the State

The Folk, Round and Square Dance Federation of North Carolina (www.ncfederation.org) hosted its annual fall meeting on Saturday, December 3, in Winston-Salem, NC. The Federation and more than 125 Western style dance clubs have been promenading to raise funds for hospices for more than 25 years.

Since 1990, the Federation has raised more than \$950,000 to support quality end of life care for North Carolinians. These dedicated dancers raised over \$27,000.00 this year. The proceeds from these efforts will be distributed to nearly 30 hospices in North Carolina through The Carolinas Center for Hospice and End of Life Care in Cary, North Carolina ("The Carolinas Center").

The Carolinas Center, a 501(c) (3) charitable organization (www.cchospice.org), is the premier association for the hospice and end of life industry throughout the Carolinas. Since its inception in 1977, The Carolinas Center has been a powerful advocate and leading voice for the industry. The Carolinas Center's extensive educational offerings and technical assistance are known nationally for their excellence. The Carolinas Center is leading the advancement of quality end of life care for all Carolinians, now and into the future.
